JA's key pillars ignite the spark in young people to realize the opportunities and realities of work and life in the 21st century.




ANNUAL REACH




Students NEED 21st Century Work Skills

MAJOR INITIATIVES

Sustainable Neighborhood Solutions

The SNS is a 3-day intensive effort focused on identifying catalytic recommendations to improve a neighborhood's stability. Global Green has implemented Sustainable Neighborhood Solutions (SNSs) in **29** communities throughout the United States.

Coalition for Resource Recovery (CoRR)

CoRR aims to find national solutions for resource and asset recovery. The Coalition's vision is to eliminate the concept of waste so that the waste from one activity is food for another, benefitting the economy, people, and the environment. Our goal is to close the loop on materials that reduce resource loss, energy consumption, and greenhouse gas emissions which cause climate change.

Climate Parks

A climate park is a fully inclusive, integrated biospheric program for any given site that ensures sustainability on all levels. It is self sufficient in terms of energy, water and food security and is economically sustainable. Recently, Global Green announced the first ever U.S. Climate Park - an eight-acre park to be built in Ojai, CA.



Eco-nomics targets middle grade students to acquire the knowledge and skills needed to promote personal habits which work towards environmental sustainability and sustainable lifestyles.

The Eco-nomics curriculum helps students understand the greenhouse effect, the benefits of nature, forms of production, sustainable development and more! It also encourages them to become "Ecoambassadors" within their own communities.

CURRICULUM DETAILS

The Eco-nomics programs consists of *(7) 90-minutes sessions, each focusing on a different area related to climate change.

Once all sessions have been completed, each school will develop a project centered around one of Global Green's global initiatives -Water for Life, Smart Energy, Social & Medical, Environmental Sustainability and Value Change.

Schools will compete against each other for a cash prize, and the winner will use the prize money to implement their climate change solution/concept within their neighborhood.
